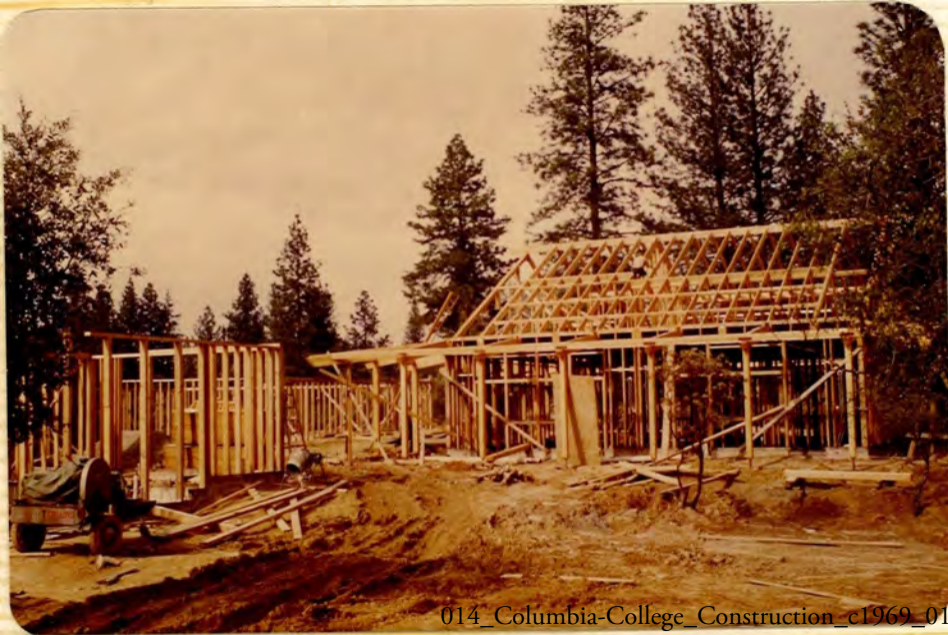

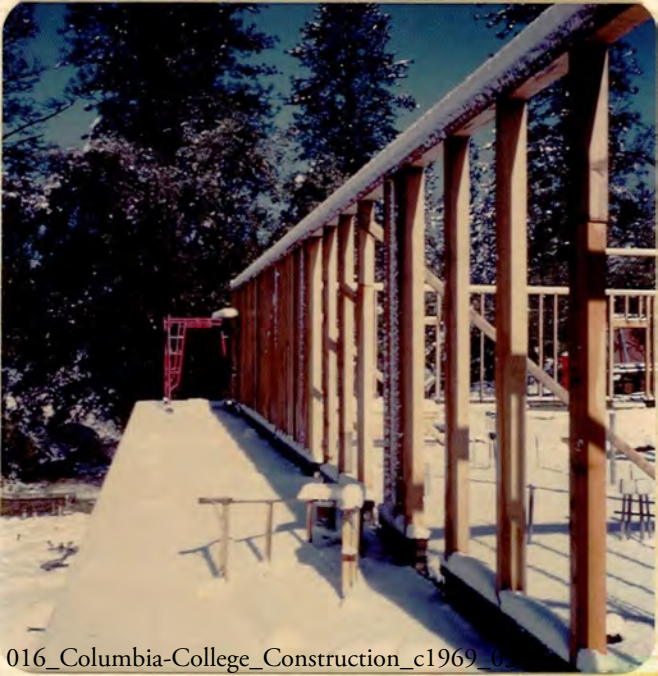

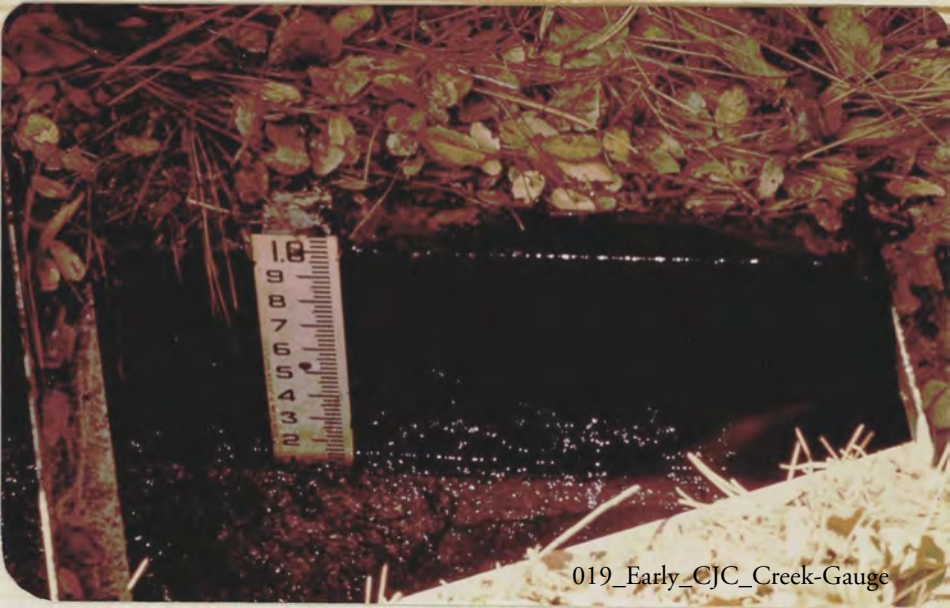

Three to join college's hall of fame

Dr. Patricia Hertert, Bee Waddelow and Paul McGinty will be honored for their service to Columbia College by induction into the Columbia College Foundation Hall of Fame.

The trio will be feted at the foundation's annual meeting and dinner June 14 at the Sonora Elks Lodge.

Members of the community are invited to join the foundation in honoring the new inductees. Reservations for the 6 p.m. event are due by tomorrow to Cindy Fraguero at 533-5126. Dinner tickets are \$15 each and offer a choice of prime rib or boneless stuffed chicken breast.

The foundation was established in 1990 to honor "those individuals from within the community, faculty, staff, and student body who have given extraordinary leadership to the college, brought positive recognition to the college or have served to further the college-community relationship."

The new inductees join 17 others who have been honored to date. Photographs of Hertert, Waddelow and McGinty will join those of the other inductees on display in the Rotunda of the college Manzanita Building.

Dr. Patricia Hertert

Nominators cited Hertert for her key role in the early development of the campus and acceptance of the college by the community. She was a member of an original planning committee that drew up specifications for the campus as well as developed the philosophy and mission for the college.

The statement "Columbia Col-

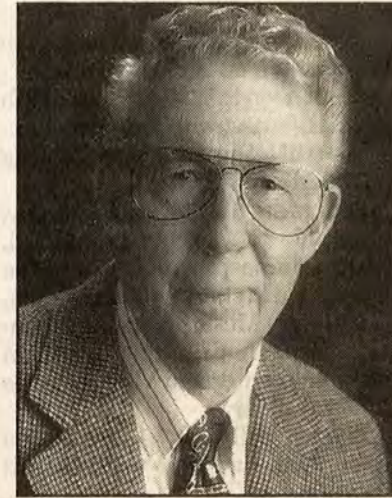

lege is dedicated to the worth and dignity of each individual student" is attributed to her. This statement appears in the college catalog.

As instructional resources consultant for Yosemite Community College District, Hertert wrote successful grant applications and obtained outside funding for the campus. One of her project proposals for a Native American project brought the campus statewide attention, one nominator said.

In her private life as Pat Rhodes, wife of Columbia's first president, Dr. Harvey B. Rhodes, she also was a strong community influence for the college. Her participation in American Association of Univer-

sity Women, Tuolumne County Historical Society and the Tuolumne County Museum Board "were all positive reflections of Columbia College and the people who were its staff."

Bee Waddelow

In her position as secretary to the Dean of Instruction from 1970 to 1990, Waddelow "wore many hats and in many ways was the 'heart-beat' of the Instruction Division," one nominator said. Another said she was a great mentor and could always be depended upon by all staff members for assistance. She served as the organizer for many college functions.

Waddelow was a charter mem-

ber of the Columbia College Foundation and has continually supported all phases of its activities. The nominator continued, "Intelligence, integrity and loyalty with a genuine concern for people are her outstanding virtues."

Through her many community affiliations, Waddelow brought "greater recognition and acceptance to the college and helped further the college-community relationship."

Paul McGinty

McGinty was affiliated with the college from 1967 to 1982. He served as inspector during the construction phase and, according to some nominators, is responsible for the beauty of the campus.

"Paul was there when the bulldozer came in to clear the site for the Columbia campus. He was there to see that not one tree was removed that did not have to be removed. Thus, we have campus buildings snuggled amongst the trees. A truly beautiful campus!"

After the campus was completed McGinty served as head of buildings and grounds. He was always available to handle any problem and could usually be found at the bottom of a ditch or tangled in electrical wires. One nominator lauded him for his maintenance of the campus "even during the years of budget and staff cuts..."

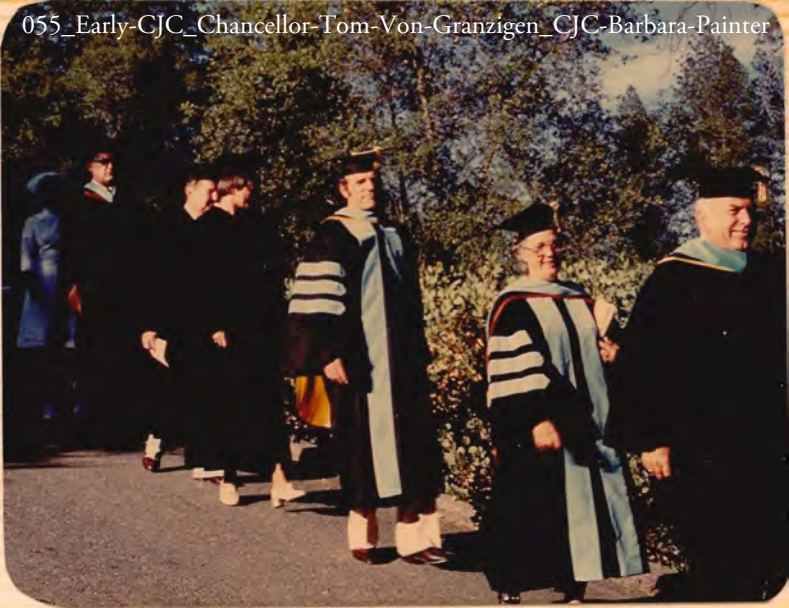

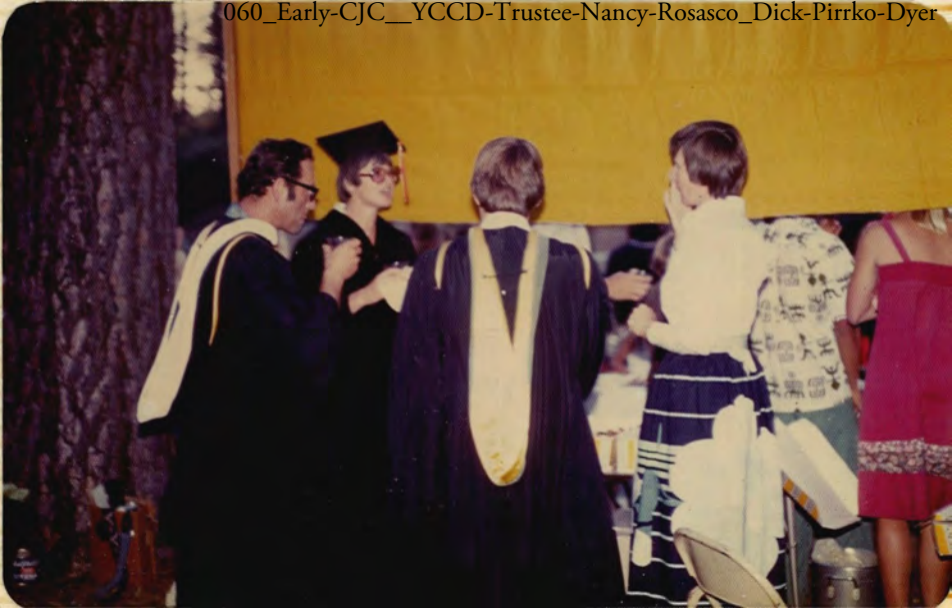
